

# H'Artworks Gallery – Watercolour course.

## Material list for watercolour course.

Pencils, HB – B – 2B

Eraser.

Watercolour box or tubes, (Student quality is fine), Reeves or Daler-Rowney are good.

Plastic pallet for mixing paint.

Selection of round brushes (Synthetic is fine) in a mixture of sizes eg 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 0.

Look for “Gold Taklon” at the range.

Large wash brush with point size 30 (Daler-Rowney omega 3 system brush ideal). A fan brush & a rigger No3 are also useful.

A few flat headed (Chisel) 2 or 3 brushes for washes, 1 ½ 38mm and ¾” 19mm are ideal.

Masking tape and Masking fluid.

Board to tape paper to, 16” by 22” or a tilting / tabletop easel

Watercolour paper 140lbs (300gm) type required is called “Not Cold Pressed” in Sizes 10” x 17” and 7” x 10”.

### Optional -

Pad of tinted paper – Ingres or similar (Pastel paper).

Granulation medium.

Box of watercolour pencils, Box of Pastels and also a box of gouache tubes. Caran’D’ache or Derwent pencils are the best, and “The Range” on Caernarfon Road has most of these in stock.

(People can borrow the pencils and pastels initially).
